The leaders of these chapters along with their Regional Directors are doing a fantastic job working to get the requirements completed to become an affiliate chapter. If you see an AWMI social media post, please consider liking it and sharing it. This will help us promote not only the 2 provisional chapters but all our chapters.

All chapters did an excellent job in meeting their challenges in 2023 by offering great programs and giving back to their current members to not only get the 2022 members renewed but also doing an impressive job in growing their individual chapters. We ended 2023 with 1,567 members and 78 Corporate members. As we continue to put on great programs and provide all our members (Corporate and regular) with what they are looking for in an organization, AWMI will continue to be strong and grow!!

Based on our February 29th membership report we currently have 1,411 members, which is an 18% increase over 2023's total at this time! Of the 1,411 members, 1,028 are renewals and 383 are brand new members. We currently have 59 corporate members with 9 of them being new corporate members. Thank you to everyone as it takes a village.

As I receive invitations from many of our chapters, I know that they are planning magnificent events for 2024. 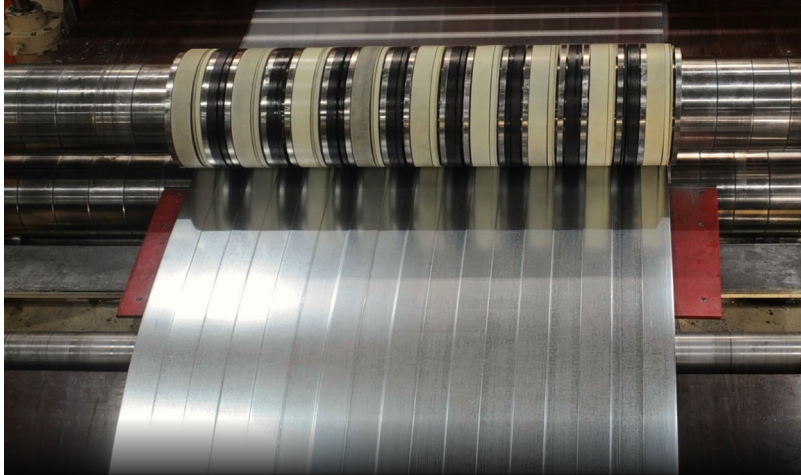
